

#### # Track 1

#### # Track 2

#### Data Analytics and Business Decision-Making

[DAB] The goal of this course is to study concepts and techniques for data analysis and exercise with open source tool. This course is to help students enhance decision-making for managers.

### # Track 3 Sustainability

[SUS] The course assists students in developing a general understanding of globalization's effects on climate. Students will gain a general knowledge of policies associated with decarbonization as intended measures to contain climate change impacts.
