1. Introduction

This class is designed for students who have received the first level of the Korean Language Proficiency Test(TOPIK) or students who are equivalent to this level. The class runs five times a week from July 5 to July 23 for three hours a day. In this class, students learn the various conjunctive ending and markers, commanding expression and vocabularies which are used in daily life. With these learning, students can speak, listen and write on topics that are interesting and familiar in their daily life.

2. Course Objectives

The purpose of this class is to develop the ability to communicate with familiar topics in everyday life. Therefore, the following objectives can be achieved through this class.

- 1) Students can write, read, and understand sentences using basic connections and markers.
- 2) Students can speak, listen, and understand familiar topics (daily work, hobbies, food, shopping, etc.).
- 3) Students can get some information about places they frequently visit in their daily life(restaurants, shops, movie theaters, etc.) and public places (hospital, bank, train station, etc.).

3. Class types and activities

This class will be consist of live class and lecture video.

At the beginning of the class, we decide together how many live classes will be held. Students learn basic grammar and vocabulary through Lecture video clip. Students can practice speaking, listening and reading activities with class mates in live class.

4. Teaching Method / Support System in Use / Teaching tools

Since this class is conducted online, the professor will upload basic textbooks and materials on Ajou Bb. Students can download class materials on Ajou Bb.

5. Knowledge and ability required for taking this course

The first level of the Korean Language Proficiency Test(TOPIK)
