1. Introduction

Academic Korean Speaking & Listening is designed for students with proficiency in Topic Level 2 or higher. This course aims to develop student's interpersonal and presentational abilities for oral communication in Korean needed in the college and daily life. The classes are to be offered for 3 hours from Monday to Friday starting from July 5 to 23. In this course, students will be able to learn Korean from beginner to intermediate level focusing on daily life topics and use them in real life. As it is expected to improve Korean language skills through the class activities, learners can also broaden their understanding toward Korean culture.

2. Course Objectives

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- Express the simple idea of their own thoughts after reading short articles or social topics.
- Identify the expressions used in sentences or paragraphs and recognize their contents focusing on grammar and vocabulary expanded from the beginner to the intermediate level.
- Learn the expressions used in real life and use them according to the situation through listening practice and speaking activities.
- Improve practical communication skills that can be used in real life and enhance integrated language skills by reading and writing activities related to the subject.
- Understand and acquire Korean culture based on improved Korean language skills.

3. Class types and activities

- Study vocabulary and expressions centering on familiar social subjects that need to be known at the intermediate level, and progress in stages so that listening and speaking can be continued
- Lectures are conducted using main textbooks, subsidiary textbooks, PPT, handouts, etc.
- Exchange thoughts and discuss opinions among learners through small group activities after watching and listening to videos related to the topic
- Present discourse content and vocabulary expressions related to the topics, practice speaking and presentation in various situations through pair and group activities as well as instructor's feedback
- Check and evaluate the learning contents through quizzes and formative evaluations

4. Teaching Method / Support System in Use / Teaching tools

- Online classes
- Participate in class through Zoom and Ajou Bb
- Real-time class and recorded video class concurrently
- Prepare the main textbook in advance, check the Ajou Bb posts and class materials before attending
- Daily class review and quiz at Ajou Bb
- Submit the results of learning activities and group assignments to Ajou Bb

5. Knowledge and ability required for taking this course

This course is available to the students who can briefly talk about everyday topics and familiar social subjects after completing the beginner's course in Korean. Also, it is aimed at students with the level 2 of TOPIK or higher, and students who can speak, listen and understand using the grammar below can also take the class.
