5. How to Participate:

1 Food Festival - Booth Operation & Booth Exhibition

World Food Festival is the main event for Ajou International Day. International students of the same nationality can form one group and introduce their culture and tradition in the most creative manner. One booth will be given to each group to represent their country. Cook traditional dishes, bring costumes, decorate the booth with objects indigenous to your country, or stage performances.

- Students can decorate the allocated booth with their traditional costumes and cultural decorative objects, and also play music to better introduce their cultures.
- For the preparation, the booth preparation fee of 150,000 won will be given to each group. Due to the lack of cooking facilities, simple, easy-to-prepare dishes are highly recommended.
- Visitors will buy the coupon on spot and students can sell the dishes at prices between 500 won and 1000 won.
- All visitors of the International Day will cast a vote for the best booth decoration and the best food, and the 100,000 won will be offered to the winner!

• Form a group with students from your country according to the guidelines below.

<Booth Operation Guidelines>

- The minimum of 2 international students needed per group to be given a booth
- If no 2 persons are of the same nationality, then fill the group with students with similar regional and cultural backgrounds
 - (i.g.) Guatemala & Ecuador → Central AmericaTansania & Kenya → East Africa
- 2 ~ 3 of Ajou students will be there in each booth as a volunteer.
- If you cannot locate another student of the same nationality as you are, please submit the form and the request to the OIA for the arrangement.
- If you have classes on the day, you must individually ask for the professor's permission to skip the class and join the Festival. The OIA will issue the certificate of participation if necessary.

Performances

During the Festival, students will have the chance to boast their skills such as traditional dancing, singing, costume parade and other programs designed to highlight tradition. Any students who want to show their talents are welcomed.

- Only group performances will be allowed. Groups organized with students from different countries are also welcome.
- Performances are optional. The best performing team will be selected and given a prize.
- The OIA will select the teams most effectively introducing their cultures.
- Performance time: around 5 minutes per team
