 ※ Class: Feb 6th ~ Jun 27th, 2017 [For 4 months]
- o For: 15 people for Beginner, 12 people for Elementary, and 15 people for Intermediate
- o Qualification
 - Must be a foreigner living in Suwon, who can attend until the end of the course
 - Those who can spend time with a Korean Buddy for supplementary study and conversational practice
 - *Preferred
 - Those who are working in Suwon
- Class levels : Beginner, Elementary, Intermediate
 **Courses are free of charge, but students should buy textbooks themselves
