

# Halla·Newcastle PBL Education and Research Center, Research Funding Call for Proposals

## 1. Purpose of the funding

- Invite quality research / scholarly journal articles to Journal of Problem-Based Learning (JPBL)
- Provide opportunities for international academics to discuss new and innovative learning and teaching strategies
- Increase public awareness of Halla·Newcastle PBL Education and Research Center

## 2. Funding

- Each research project funds a maximum of 2,000,000 Korean Won (Approx. 1,700USD)
- 5 Funding schedules

## 3. Areas to fund

- Research on Problem-Based Learning
- Research on innovative teaching and learning strategies including PBL, Simulation, Project(or Case)-based learning, Team teaching, Online learning, Learning with IT technologies, Strategies for effective group works and etc.

## 4. Eligibility

- Academics and organizations of any country
- Grants will not be provided to individuals or organizations that have failed to provide a proper acquittal of an earlier grant provided by other institutions and/ or National Research Foundation of Korea.
- Research conducted without permission from an Institutional Review Board (IRB) will be excluded.

## 5. Application

- **Deadline: June 24th 2016 (17:00 Korean local time)**
- All applicants will be required to complete the Application Form attached, and provide all mandatory requested documentation. The application and the research proposal must be in English or Korean. Any application that does not meet these minimum requirements will be deemed ineligible.
- Applications must be received by the deadline 2016. 6. 24 (Friday) 17:00 via email [iimj@chu.ac.kr](mailto:iimj@chu.ac.kr), or [mypark@chu.ac.kr](mailto:mypark@chu.ac.kr). ## 6. Preparing your application

- Please ensure you have:
  - ▷ Completed all mandatory fields on the application form.
  - ▷ Clearly demonstrated how your proposal meets the objectives of this Funding.
  - ▷ Made adequate provision for all likely expenses.
  - ▷ As the Halla-Newcastle PBL Education and Research Center Board's decision will be based on the information provided, applicants should ensure all information provided is accurate, clear and comprehensive.
  - ▷ The primary findings of research should be published on JPBL. However, publishing date is subject to the journal reviewers' recommendation.

## 7. Appraisal Criteria

- 1) First stage: Mandatory requirements of grant applications:
  - ▷ Is the grant consistent with the funding objectives?
  - ▷ Complete and correctly filled in?
  - ▷ That there are no outstanding acquittals from any previous grant.
- 2) Second stage: Quality of the application, taking into account:
  - ▷ Has the project been clearly and well thought out?
  - ▷ Are there clear and achievable timeframes?
  - ▷ Are there clear, measurable and realistic results defined?
  - ▷ Are details of the project confirmed?
  - ▷ Track record of delivering on such projects?

## 8. Funding expenses

- Halla-Newcastle Education and Research Center has a policy of supporting innovative proposals in a broad range of areas. Funding generally supports any research expenses including translation and editing of a journal article.
- Grants are not normally available for the following purposes:
  - ▷ Capital expenditure in real property, equipment or computer software.
  - ▷ Conference travel.
  - ▷ Salary for the researcher, research assistants, administrative staff, etc.
  - ▷ Funding of completed projects.
- Successful application will be notified in early July 2016 and 50% of fund will be given at the start of the project. The rest will be provided when the final report is successfully passed by Halla Newcastle PBL Education and Research Center.

## **9. Final Report**

- **Deadline: December 15th 2016 (17:00 Korean local time)**
- The final report must be in English or Korean.
- A draft of journal article should be written in English only.
- Grant moneys should be acquitted within 28 days of the completion of a project through the submission of a completed Acquittal report including a financial statement of expenditure (receipts).
- All unspent funds must be returned to Halla Newcastle PBL Education and Research Center.
- If unable to publish the research findings to JPBL, Halla·Newcastle Education and Research Center can discontinue or reclaim of all funding already provided.
