

Mr. Ambrose S K Lam

Mr. Lam is one of the founding partners of Lam Lee & Lai, a local solicitors firm established in 1991. He graduated from the University of Essex, UK and was admitted as a Solicitor of Hong Kong in 1988, also in Singapore and the UK in 1993. He was later appointed a China-Appointed Attesting Officers by the Ministry of Justice of PRC in 2003. Mr. Lam practises mainly in conveyancing and commercial law.

Mr. Lam has been a Council Member of the Law Society of Hong Kong since 2004 and chairs its Greater China Legal Affairs Committee and Consents Committee. He was first elected a Vice President in May 2011 and was reelected in May 2012.

Mr. Lam was appointed a member of the Bar Issues Commission Policy Committee of International Bar Association, the largest organisation of the legal profession in the world, starting from 1 January 2013 for a term of four years.
