

# **Degree-Seeking LLM Exchange Students from Our Partner Institutions**

### **Application Priority Dates**


For fall semester or full year: March 1 For spring semester: November 1

Failure to apply by the stated deadlines could delay the processing of visa documents necessary to make your travel arrangements. It is not possible to begin the semester after the first day of classes.

#### **How to Apply**

The home university should provide the Assistant Dean for International Programs with the name and contact information of the LLM nominee by March 1 (Fall enrollment) or November 1 (Spring enrollment). Nominees should then complete the Indiana University online electronic application, or <a href="Mailto:eApp">eApp</a> (<a href="https://onestart.iu.edu/sisad-prd/p/Guest.do?methodToCall=start&inst=IUBLA&career=GRAD&parm1=DEGR">https://onestart.iu.edu/sisad-prd/p/Guest.do?methodToCall=start&inst=IUBLA&career=GRAD&parm1=DEGR</a>)

- Select "Law Special Programs" as the academic program to which you are applying
- Select "Law Graduate Exchange" as the academic plan.



You should use the corresponding upload spaces on the eApp to provide your personal statement and resume, and use the "Departmental Questions" upload space for your academic transcripts and test scores (if available).

Unless otherwise noted, LLM exchange students will receive a waiver of tuition (up to 24 credits) and mandatory fees. They will also receive international student health insurance. They are responsible for their own travel, books, room and board, and miscellaneous expenses.



## **Department Information/Recommendations**

Maurer School of Law only requires one recommendation / nomination for exchange program students; however, the eApp requires three recommenders to be entered before the application can be submitted. To bypass this issue:

- Enter the contact information for your exchange program coordinator for your first recommendation.
- For recommendations 2 & 3, simply include **your own** contact information.

# **Proof of Funding**

All US universities are required to collect proof of funding information for international applicants. This documentation is required for visa documents and visa interview. *Delay in sending proof of funding = delay in getting visa* 

- you must show sufficient funds to cover living expenses, books and health insurance
