

ENGLISH FOR SMALL TALK & EVERYDAY CONVERSATIONS

APRIL 5 – JUNE 9, 2021

Mondays and Wednesdays, 7:30 – 9:30 a.m. EST

(CEFR B1, Intermediate) Students practice small talk and everyday conversations. Students will attend 20 live online lessons via Zoom over 10 weeks for a total of 40 hours of instruction. Each lesson is two hours. Readings, vocabulary flashcards, MP3s, and other course material will all be provided by the instructor each Friday. Upon completion of the 10 week course, students will receive a certificate of completion with quiz grades, hours attended, and CEFR level. Students will receive a certificate of completion (with quiz grades, hours attended, and CEFR level) only if the student (a) attends a minimum of 30 of 40 hours of live instruction, (b) achieves a minimum of 75% on average for quizzes, and (c) submits their final 50 minute EFSET score.

Week 3 – How do you politely ask about and share personal information? (family, education, work experience)

Week 4 – How do you compare and contrast holidays?

Week 7 – How do you talk about TV shows, movies, art, music?

Week 8 – How do you talk about traveling and weather?

Week 9 – How do you talk about languages?

Week 10 – How do you talk about the future?

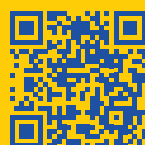

Tuesdays and Thursdays, 7:30 – 9:30 a.m. EST

(CEFR B2, Intermediate) Students will prepare to study abroad in the U.S. by learning the language and culture of U.S. higher education. Students will attend 20 live online lessons via Zoom over 10 weeks for a total of 40 hours of instruction. Each lesson is two hours. Readings, vocabulary flashcards, MP3s, and other course material will all be provided by the instructor each Friday. Upon completion of the 10 week course, students will receive a certificate of completion with quiz grades, hours attended, and CEFR level. Students will receive a certificate of completion (with quiz grades, hours attended, and CEFR level) only if the student (a) attends a minimum of 30 of 40 hours of live instruction, (b) achieves a minimum of 75% on average for quizzes, and (c) submits their final 50 minute EFSET score.
