Housing	Housing is guaranteed (International House, the dormitory) https://ewww.kumamoto-u.ac.jp/en/prospective/accommodation/international_house/ You may rent a public apartment if you wish. https://ewww.kumamoto-u.ac.jp/en/prospective/accommodation/others/ Exchange students from partner schools are not required to live on campus and may find their own accommodations in the area, but should be aware that finding off-campus housing, especially for only one semester, can be challenging. Spots in campus housing are reserved for exchange students.
Room Type at International House	Building C or D: each unit with 4 rooms of single occupancy - Living room, Shower room, Toilet, and Laundry are shared - Each room is furnished with a single bed, desk, chair, and telephone (incoming calls only) Fees: 17,000 JPY/monthly rent + 10,000 JPY one-time deposit
Cost of Living	Approximately, 80,000 JPY/month if you choose to live in the dormitory. Approximately, 100,000 JPY/month if you choose to rent a public apartment.
Health Insurance	The mandatory Japanese health insurance can be procured upon arrival in Kumamoto (approx. 3,000 JPY per month)
